#### Constructing Elysians

Before assembling the models ensure that the parts are neatly trimmed and cleaned. Gluing the legs to the base first gives a good starting point. We recommend that you Bluetack the model in the pose you would like first before attempting to glue the model together.

TIP: Heating areas of the model such as the collar or arms with hot air or water can soften those parts allowing additional reposing of the model.

IA-GUA-I-011 comes with Grav-chutes. These attach to the recess in the back of the torso.



This kit contains all the pieces required to produce an Elysian Missile Squad


To glue the resin pieces together use Citadel Super Glue.

NOTE: We have cast this kit using the most advanced techniques and the best quality resin, but due to the nature of the casting process your model may contain very slight air bubbles. These can easily be filled with model filler or super glue. Any slight warpage of thin parts can easily be corrected by Immersing the part in hot tap water for about 1 minute then carefully bending it back into shape.
