LEGION SICARAN ARCUS STRIKE TANK

As part of a program initiated by the Primarch Guilliman, seeking to grant a Legion strike force access to highly specialised weapon systems without the need to employ numerous vehicles for each role, the Sicaran hull was chosen to mount the newly developed arcus launcher, allowing small Legiones Astartes forces to operate without extensive support and in smaller numbers than during the Great Crusade. One variant of note utilised the neutron-flux warhead, a Terran development dating back to the years prior to the alliance with Mars. This weapon saturates the silica stratum of the cybernetica cortex employed by Mechanicum automata with xenon, causing terminal cascade failures in these systems. The continued production of these weapons was the cause of the Mechanicum's refusal to sanction the Arcus pattern hull.





Preparing the Model for Assembly

Before assembling the model, wash each part thoroughly with an abrasive brush, such as a toothbrush, to remove any model release agent that may still be on the surface of the parts. For a more detailed information consult the working with resin guide included in this box.

This kit contains all the pieces required to construct a Legion Sicaran Arcus Strike Tank. To glue the resin pieces together, use Citadel Super Glue.

NOTE: We have cast this kit using advanced techniques and the best quality resin, but due to the nature of the casting process, your model may contain small air bubbles. These can easily be filled with model filler or super glue. Any slight warpage of thin parts can be corrected by immersing the part in hot tap water for about 1 minute, then carefully bending it back into shape.




30. Right Launcher Exhaust 31. Left Launcher Exhaust

The Targeter and the Lower Pivot should be glued into the body of the chosen weapon. So the weapon will traverse, avoid getting glue on the Sponson Turret itself.

For the Lascannon option, omit stages 9 and 10.


16. Gun Shield
