PREPARING A MODEL FOR ASSEMBLY

Before assembling a model, wash each part thoroughly with an abrasive brush, such as a toothbrush, to remove any model release agent that may still be on the surface of the parts. Then, remove any excess resin such as mould lines, casting gates, vents and shims.

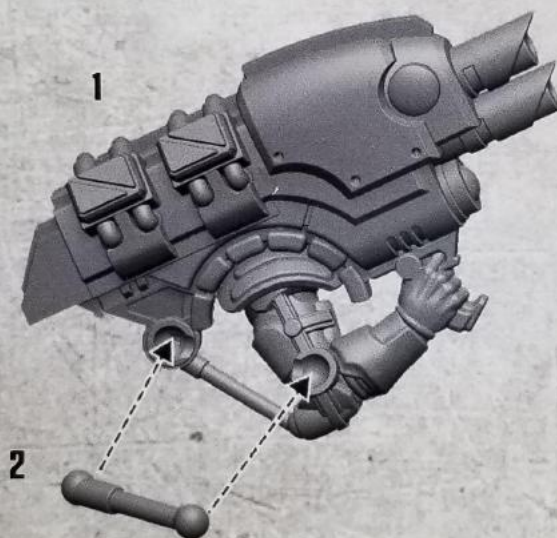

This kit contains all of the pieces required to construct a Van Saar Champion and three Cyberachnids. To glue the resin pieces together, use Super Glue.

NOTE: We have cast this kit using advanced techniques and the best quality resin, but due to the nature of the casting process, your model may contain small air bubbles. These can be filled with model filler or super glue. Any slight warpage of thin parts can easily be corrected by immersing the part in hot tap water for about 1 minute, then carefully bending it back into shape.

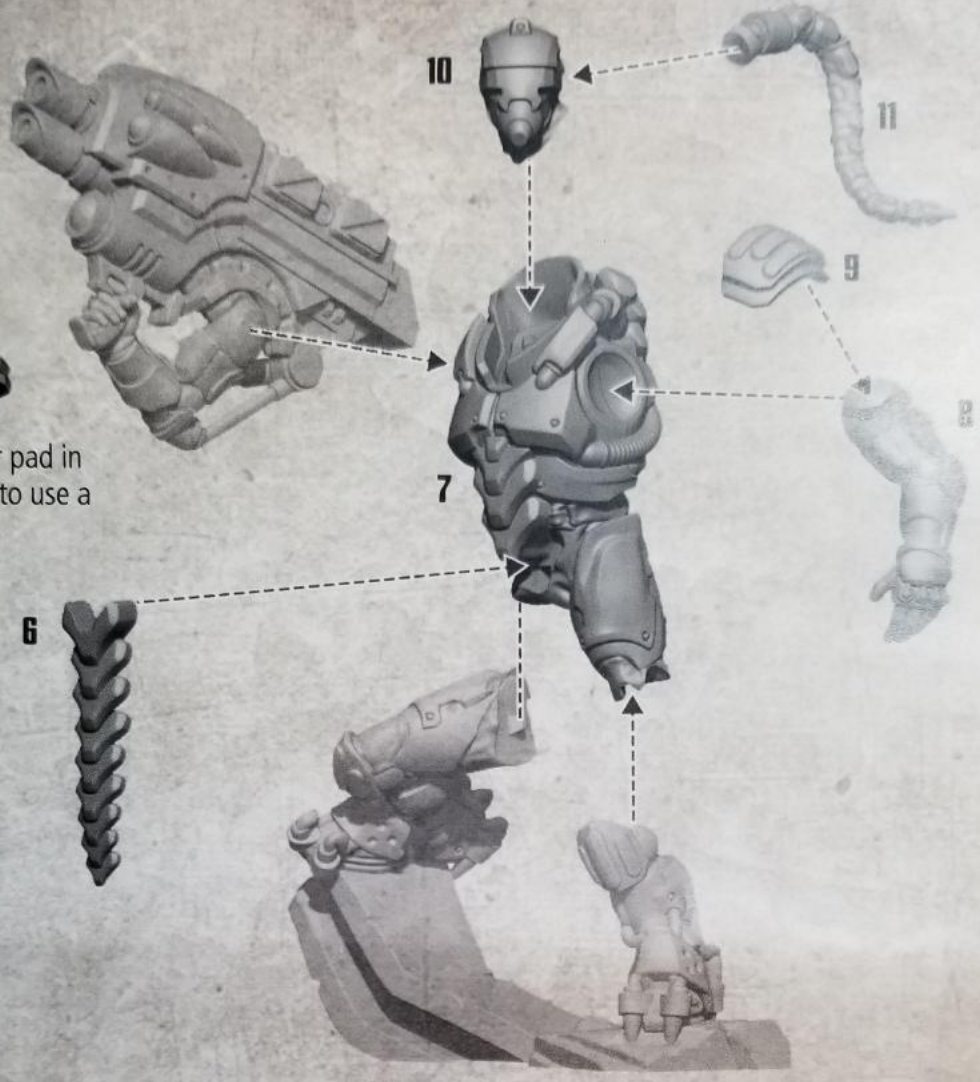

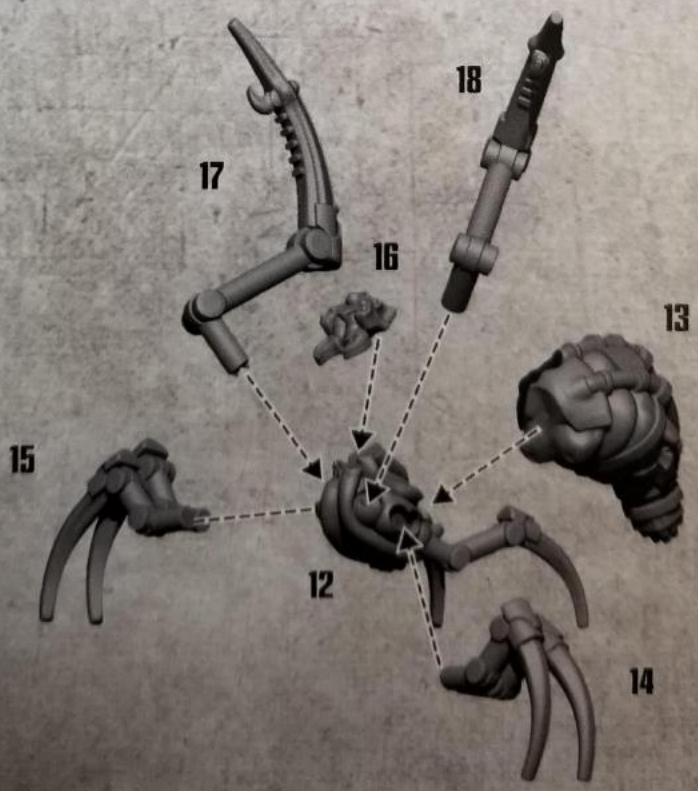

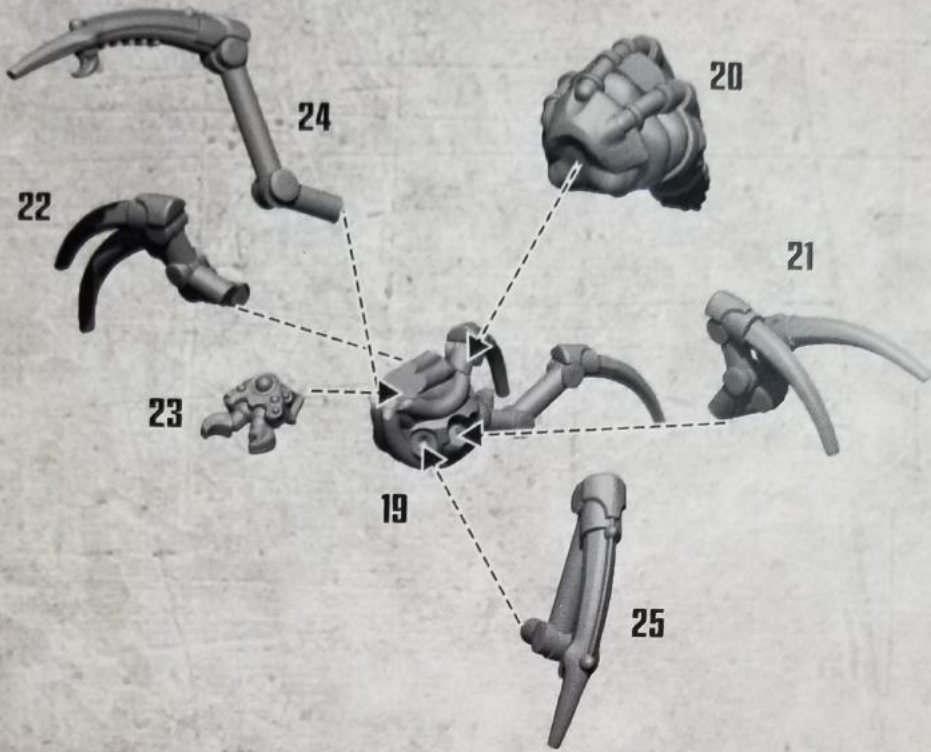
CYBERACHNID 1

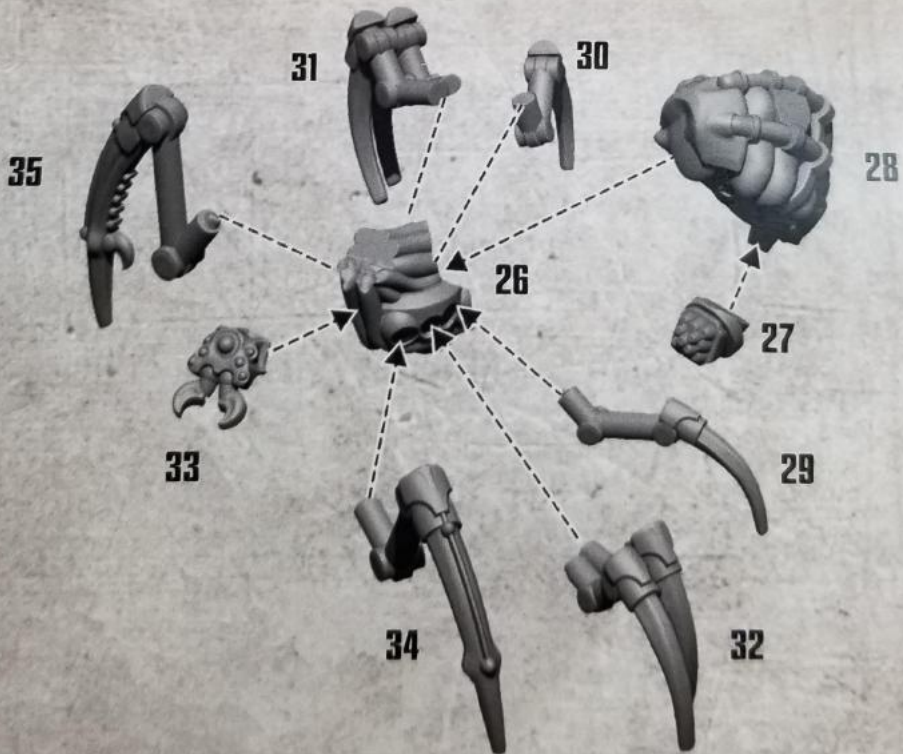
CYBERACHNID 2
