
WHITE SCARS LEGION GOLDEN KESHIG JETBIKE

Among the most prestigious of the White Scars' main combat units are their heavy assault jetbike squads – often collectively referred to as the 'Golden Keshig'. These superlatively-skilled riders act as linebreakers and assault units par excellence, often serving where other Legions would prefer to deploy heavy armour or massed Terminator units.

Resin Components

Before assembly, check that none of the components are missing.



This set also includes a large flying base and small flying stems.

Preparing a Model for Assembly

Before assembling a model, wash each part thoroughly with an abrasive brush, such as a toothbrush, to remove any model release agent that may still be on the surface of the parts. Then, remove any excess resin such as mould lines, casting gates, vents and shims.

For a more detailed guide to working with resin models, go to the Downloads section of the Forge World website. This kit contains all of the pieces required to construct a White Scars Legion Golden Keshig Jetbike. To glue the resin pieces together use Citadel Super Glue.

NOTE: We have cast this kit using advanced techniques and the best quality resin, but due to the nature of the casting process, your model may contain small air bubbles. These can be filled with model filler or super glue. Any slight warpage of thin parts can easily be corrected by immersing the part in hot tap water for about 1 minute, then carefully bending it back into shape.
